Directions

From Garden State Parkway (North or South):

Take Exit 117 to Route 36. Make a right at the first traffic light (Main Street). You will pass one street on your left (Atlantic Street). Make the next left onto Florence Avenue.

From Matawan and points North on Route 35:

Take Route 35 South, merge onto Route 36. Make a right at the first traffic light (Main Street). You will pass one street on your left (Atlantic Street). Make the next left onto Florence Avenue.

From Keyport:

Take Broad Street towards Route 36. Go through traffic light (cross Route 36). You will pass one street on your left (Atlantic Street). Make the next left onto Florence Avenue.

From Union Beach and points East on Route 36:

Take Route 36 West towards Garden State Parkway. Go through the traffic light at Broad Street (Keyport). Immediately after this light, make a right and follow the signs for the U-turn. The U-turn will put you on Broad Street. Go through traffic light (cross Route 36). You will pass one street on your left (Atlantic Street). Make the next left onto Florence Avenue.

From Hazlet and points South on Route 35:

Take Route 35 North towards Garden State Parkway. Make a right at the Main Street/Holmdel Road traffic light. Make first right onto Florence Avenue.

From Holmdel:

Take Holmdel Road towards Route 35. Go through the traffic light (cross Route 35). Holmdel Road becomes Main Street. Make right at Florence Avenue.
